- 1. <u>Tree Application No WD/CA/17/00078</u> 15 Napier Close, Puncknowle The previous application No WD/CA/17/00004 to fell 5 trees had been withdrawn & this application was now to fell 4 trees. It was agreed to Object to this Application for the same reasons as the 1<sup>st</sup> application.
- 2. <u>Application No WD/D/17/000467</u> Blue Anchor Café, Beach Road, West Bexington Make alterations to existing café building, amend parking arrangements and construct 3 wooden shelters Agreed to Object as Over-development of the site only parking spaces for up to 7 cars. No Disabled Access no ramps or handrails & no disabled access to the Toilets. Just 1 female & 1 male Toilet in Plans this is inadequate for the number of proposed diners & no staff toilets.
